Although last September we had 2 speakers on the new Massachusetts Department of Fire Services (DFS) Hazardous Material Processing regulation (527 CMR 33), we felt it was worthwhile to have a second meeting with additional speakers and new information.

Inspector Jose Machado from the Worcester Fire Department will provide data on the Class 5 submittals they received, discuss whether they had much advance communications with those companies, comment on what they are looking for from the Class 2 through 4 submittals, and comment on whether they intend to require the use of third party reviews.

Dana Haagensen is a Fire Protection Engineer with the Massachusetts Department of Fire Services. He will review the requirements of the 527 CMR 33 regulation, comment on any new developments, and make any observations that he feels are pertinent regarding what companies need to do to meet the regulation.

Andy Irwin is the President of IRWIN Engineers, a professional consulting firm located in Natick specializing in chemical and environmental engineering. He will speak on Assembling Process Information and the Process Vessel Design Basis, Reactive Chemical Interaction Matrix - NOAA free software tool, Process Hazard Evaluation, and Emergency Response Planning and Accident Prevention.

Directions to WRCC, Worcester, MA

Directions are to the Worcester Common Outlet Garage on Commercial Street, which is the recommended parking location.

FROM I- 90/MASSACHUSETTS TURNPIKE:

Take Exit 10 - Auburn to Route 290 East. Follow route 290 East to Exit 16. At the end of the ramp, turn left onto East Central Street. Go straight through the next two sets of lights. Turn left at the next set of traffic lights (facing the DCU Center) onto Major Taylor Boulevard. Turn right at the next set of traffic lights (facing Worcester Common Outlets) onto Foster Street. Take left at the next set of lights onto Commercial Street and enter Worcester Common Outlet Garage on left.

FROM ROUTE 290 WEST

Follow Route 290 West to Exit 16. At the end of the ramp, turn right onto East Central Street. Go straight through the next set of traffic lights. Turn left at the next set of traffic lights (facing the DCU Center) onto Major Taylor Boulevard. Turn right at the next set of traffic lights (facing Worcester Common Outlets) onto Foster Street. Take left at the next set of lights onto Commercial Street and enter Worcester Common Outlet Garage on left.

Parking and Getting to WRCC:

Recommended parking is at Worcester Common Outlet Garage on Commercial Street. As you exit the garage on foot onto Commercial Street, turn left and proceed to Front Street (you'll be facing the Common). Turn right on Front and proceed to Main (City Hall will be on your left). The building is diagonally across Main St at that point on the corner of Pleasant and Main. Proceed to the main entrance of the building at 446 Main. Take elevator to the 2nd floor after signing in with security. As you step off of the elevator, turn toward the window then turn left to enter the Chamber.
