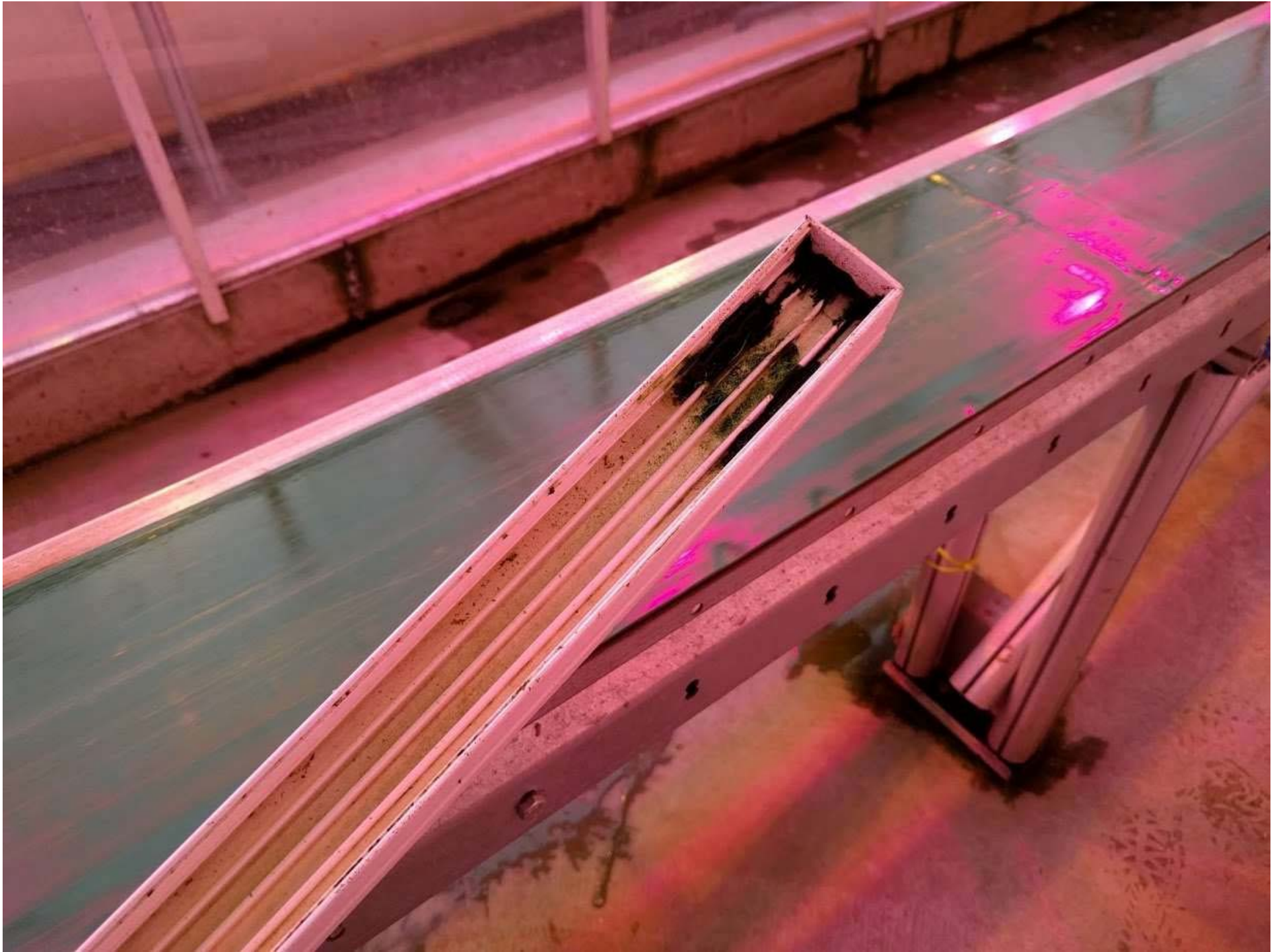

Options analysis

	Chemical sanitizer	Pressure washer
Capital expense (budgeted)	\$2,000 for pump and foaming applicator	\$10,000 for pressure washer
Operating expense	\$100+/day, depending on chemical	\$100/day
Complications	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Facility reconfiguration • Unknown toxicity of residues (employees and customers, but also seeds!) • Disposal and septic 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Permitting • Installation
More complications	Inconsistent with company's "quality" and "sustainability" values
